



Information for the Tack Sale

- ***Back by popular demand***, the format used for many years, this is the tack sale that allows sellers to deliver properly tagged merchandise in the morning, and pick up unsold items at the end of the day. PQHA/PQHVA will be responsible for displaying, monitoring, and conducting all sales. Sellers will be free to watch the clinician, and not be tied to “their table.”
- All sellers must pre-register with Corina Vogt at vogtcorina@gmail.com or contact/ text her at 814-483-6033. At this time, you will be assigned a consignor’s number.
- All clinic admissions receive free tack sale registration. *To help offset the cost of admittance, each consignor will receive a \$10 voucher toward the purchase of items at the sale.*
- All consignors must use the worksheets provided on the website www.PQHA.org to list items you are bringing to the sale (the worksheet includes a consignor’s number, item numbers, description, and price). **All items must be listed, and tagged before dropping off at the sale.**
- As a PQHYA Fundraiser, there will be a 15% commission charged for each item sold \$499 or less, and 10% commission for each item \$500 and over.
- While we display, and represent each item to the best of our ability, PQHA/PQHVA will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or broken items.
- All items should be clean and in good working order upon arrival.
- After the sale, it is the consignor’s responsibility to collect their own items. PQHA/PQHVA will not be responsible for items left behind. Items left behind will be considered a donation. Check your tags closely as you collect your items to prevent accidental removal of other items. Should this occur please contact Corina Vogt to help resolve any possible situations (although PQHA/PQHVA assumes no liability).
