



PQHA Mid-Summer Madness Exhibitors Information

PQHA is so excited to be hosting you at our horse show July 14-19 in Centre Hall. We wanted to share some important information that will help both you and our show staff make your arrival and stay at the horse show so much easier. Many of these things are related to the current social distancing climate due to Covid-19.

1. You may arrive at the grounds between 8 am and 8 pm on Monday July 13. If you need another arrival time, please email stalls@pqha.org prior to July 12. If arriving after 8 pm on Monday, July 13 call 814-880-0965 upon arrival and wait at the gate for someone to come and greet you.

Pennsylvania Governor Wolfe on July 1, 2020 is not advocating for the closing of events but mandating the use of face covering.

Facial Covering to include mask, kerchief, shield etc.

- Upon arrival EVERYONE will be asked to sign a liability release and waiver and have your temperature taken. You can do this at the gate on Monday and Tuesday or at the stall or show office Wednesday – Sunday. Arrival should be 8 am – 8 pm. If arriving outside of this time frame you must call 814-880-0965 to gain entry to the grounds.
- At that time you will be given a wristband to wear during your stay at the facility:
 - Blue – Signed waiver and temperature was checked and you will wear face covering when necessary
 - Red – Signed waiver and temperature checked and you cannot wear face covering due to a medical condition. Individuals are not required to show documentation that an exception applies.
 - Gold – Staff and board Members, signed waiver and temperature checked and will have temperature checked each day prior to the start of the show.
- You will be asked to wear face covering if you are outdoors and unable to maintain 6' social distance from people who are not members of your household.
- You will be asked to wear face covering in any indoor location when you cannot maintain 6' social distance from people who are not members of your household.
- Individuals will not be required to wear a face covering while mounted on a horse as long as the 6' social distancing is maintained.

- No one under the age of 2 is required to wear face covering.
 - You must have your face covering with you at all times.
2. One of the requirements in the State of PA, for approval to hold this show, is that each RV must be spaced 45' apart. We will mark each spot with a blue flag. If you park where there is not a flag you will be required to move. This is a state COVID requirement that we must adhere too. You may not park awning to awning or in squares, etc. This is approximately 1 unit per pole. The area behind the main barn will be reserved for show staff and board members that are helping with the management of the show. There will be plenty of hookups and we will mark all spots that have 50-amp hook-ups. We do ask that if you don't require a 50-amp plug-in that you do not use a 50-amp spot.
 3. Since camping may not be close to your barn assignment you may want to consider bringing a bike, a scooter, a personal golf cart or renting a golf cart from Jake's Carts at 717-899-6699
 4. We will accept **RV parking only (no horses)** from 4-7 pm on Sunday, July 12. Whether you plug in or not you will have to pay an additional \$40 for early arrival. Do not bring any RV's prior to this time We can not accept any horses prior to Monday, July 13 at 8 am.
 5. **Trainers** please send your trainers sheets to stalls@pqha.org prior to July 10 so we can have your clients pay upon arrival at the facilities.
 6. Please have a check or credit card ready for payment upon arrival at the fairgrounds. We will be asking that you pay upon arrival to alleviate visits to the stall office and help with COVID requirements.
 7. Bring a radio with you to place at your stalls and your camper. If you tune to 102.3 you can hear the horse show announcer.
