High Point Awards or All Around Awards will be presented in each division. To be eligible for High Point Awards or All Around Awards the exhibitor must show to all 4 judges.

High Point Awards will be presented in the following Divisions: Level 1 Amateur, Amateur Select (only Amateur Select Classes will count), Level 1 Youth, Small Fry, and EWD.

All Around Awards will be presented in the following Divisions: Open, Amateur, Youth 14-18, and Youth 13 and Under. To be eligible for the All Around award, the exhibitor must show in at least three All Around categories as outlined in the AQHA Handbook

Checks and credit cards will be processed 30 days prior to the start of the show. All refund requests prior to 9/4/2020 must be in writing with a self-addressed, stamped return envelope.
